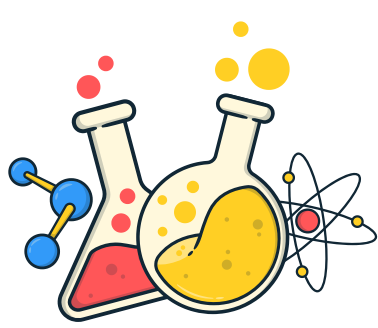
Bus Club Registration 2025-2026

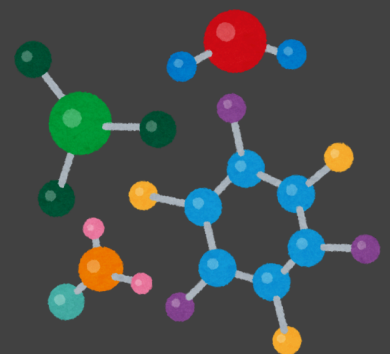

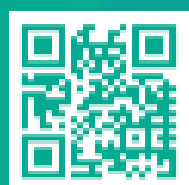
